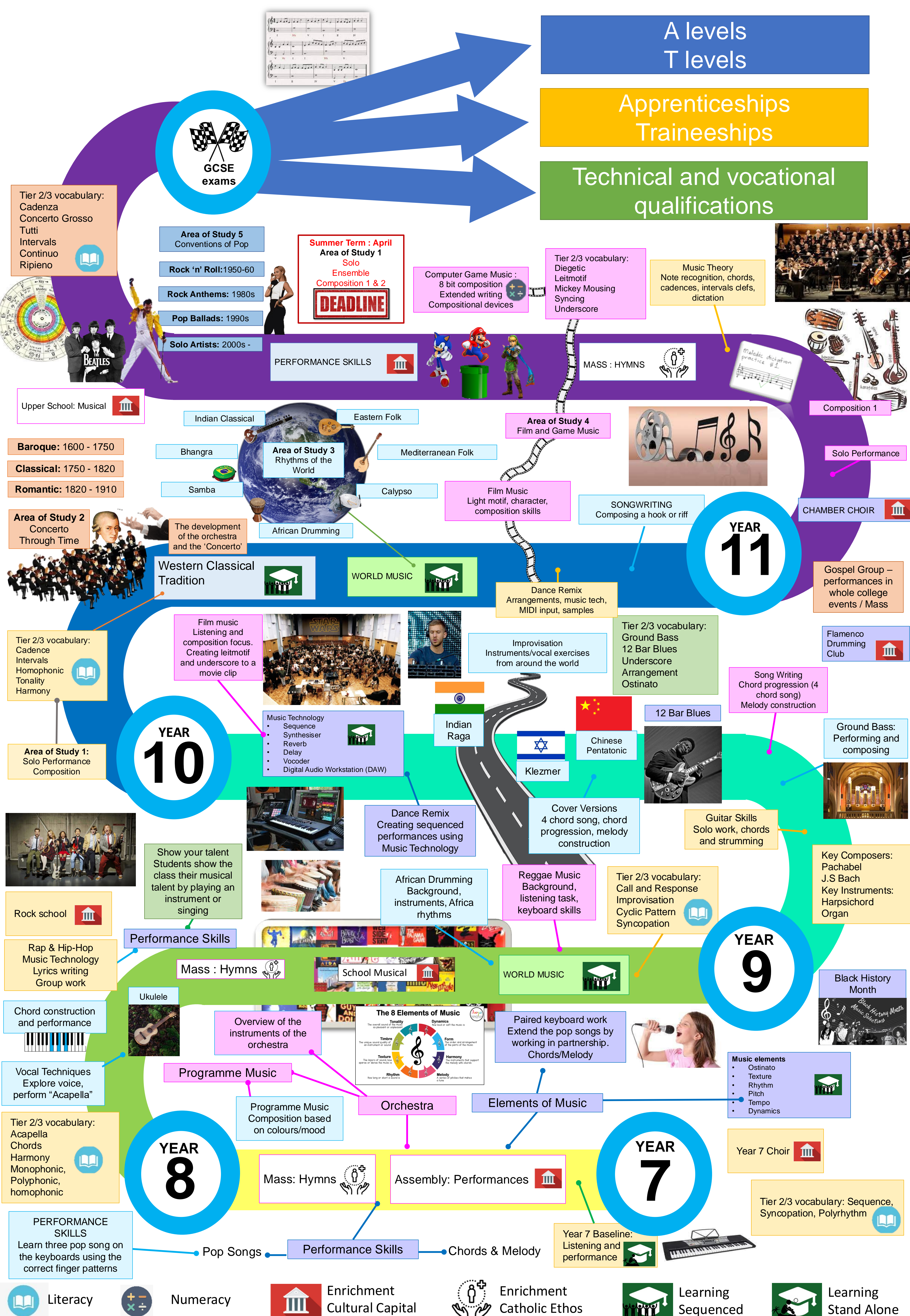




Music Department Curriculum Road Map

The Music curriculum is designed to equip students with skills and techniques that are used in musical performance, composition and analysis, whilst also giving a foundation of knowledge and music theory. Alongside this, the music curriculum supports students in developing their cultural capital and their understanding of the need for working in collaboration with others, developing their musical ability and improving self-esteem and confidence. Whilst studying music, students are encouraged to listen to different styles and genres, identifying the key features within them and exploring further through practical work.
