

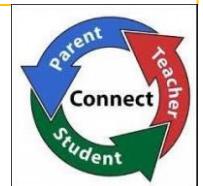


Learning Conversations at St Benedict's

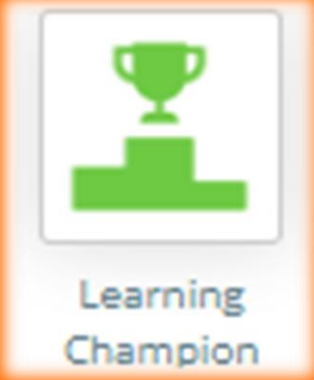
- For every positive contribution to the learning, students receive positive points which will cumulate and be rewarded with various badges.

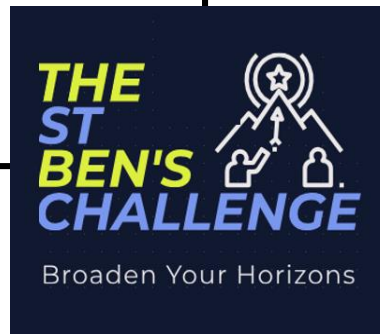
